

SUPPLIER AWARDS ATTIRE – COCKTAIL CHIC

MEN

- As a general guide, 'cocktail' means no jeans and no sneakers. You want dress chinos or suit pants, a button-up shirt or suit shirt, and a blazer or suit jacket. Ties are optional, and your footwear should look sharp and polished.
- What 'cocktail' really means is: put some effort in. It's asking you to dress up and add some oomph to your outfit. You basically want to look elegant, stylish and simple. Think about it this way: cocktail attire is one step down from formal, but one step up from smart casual.
